

Sugarland's current "Love on the Inside" concert tour through mid-November will benefit The Shalom Foundation again this fall. Jennifer Nettles' support of The Shalom Foundation was placed in the spotlight last year with the "Change" tour. During each concert held across the country, Sugarland will donate \$1 from every ticket sold to The Shalom Foundation.
